### Sliabh Liag Cliff Experience

Sliabh Liag Cliff Experience & Visitor Centre is Ireland's ultimate sea cliff adventure. The area's unrivalled beauty is truly Mother Nature's finest canvas where visitors can enjoy breathtaking views. It is a place where tales of myth and legend, local history and Irish tradition seem to be painted into the wild and rugged landscape. Walkers can enjoy an extended 3km cliff path walk while hikers can explore a 13km looped walk, incorporating the One Man's Pass and the Pilgrim's path.

### Donegal Sea Safari

Donegal Sea Adventure was established to showcase the beautiful coastline and islands of the Donegal coast. We offer a boat service providing tours and access to the islands of Inis Mhic an Duirn (Rutland), Inis Cú (Inishcoo), Inis Fraoigh (Inishfree), Íochtara (Eighter), Uaigh (Owey), and Inis Caorach (Iniskeeragh). Tours include a 1 hour & 40 minute experience on the wild Atlantic coast learning the history and folklore of the local area while searching for wildlife and adventure. ### Doe Castle

Doe Castle stands as a testament to centuries of rich heritage and timeless beauty. Step inside, and you'll be transported back in time, as you explore the grounds imposing stone walls and intricate carvings. Every corner of Doe Castle tells a story of valour, romance, and intrigue. Whether you're a history enthusiast, a family seeking adventure, or a traveller in search of wonder, Doe Castle offers something for everyone.

Doe Castle served as a home, refuge, and bastion for the MacSweeney chiefs for almost 200 years after being built in the 1420s, and some witnessed the most seismic events in Irish history including the Spanish Armada and the Battle of Kinsale. Approx 5 min from camp.
